<p><b>Plastic packaging</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastic bags</li> <li>Plastic cups, containers and jerrycans</li> <li>Plastic and Polystyrene packaging for meat, fruit, vegetables, sandwich meats or cheese</li> <li>Plastic bottles for shampoo, salad dressing, cleaning products</li> <li>Coffee/snack bags</li> <li>Plastic flowerpots</li> </ul> <p>↓</p> <p>To be rinsed out in cold water if necessary before collection. If not cleaned in cold water, then to be put with residual waste.</p>	<p><b>Food waste</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shells/peels/fruit and vegetable cores, wind falls</li> <li>Mouldy bread, biscuits, cake</li> <li>Tea bags, coffee filters, coffee grounds</li> <li>Fish, shellfish</li> <li>Left-over meat and bones</li> <li>Eggshells, nutshells</li> <li>Used paper towels and napkins in smaller quantities</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>	<p><b>Residual waste</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wrapping paper, ribbons</li> <li>Soiled plastic/paper/tubes</li> <li>CD's, tapes</li> <li>Ring binders, pens</li> <li>Hard-cover books</li> <li>Soiled clothes, shoes, textiles</li> <li>Dog waste bags, cat litter, pet dung</li> <li>Diapers</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>	<p><b>Glass &amp; metal packaging</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Glass jars and bottles</li> <li>Tins (empty)</li> <li>Aluminium foil and packaging</li> <li>Metal caps/lids</li> <li>Metal tubes</li> <li>Metal tea light containers</li> <li>Soda/beer cans with no deposit mark</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>

<p><b>Paper</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Milk cartons, juice, gravy and pudding cartons</li> <li>Newspapers</li> <li>Advertising mail, magazines</li> <li>Paperback books</li> <li>Envelopes</li> <li>Pizza and cereal boxes, egg cartons, etc.</li> <li>Toilet paper and kitchen towel roll tubes</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>

<p><b>Cardboard</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Brown cardboard boxes, corrugated cardboard</li> </ul>	<p><b>Non-flammable</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Drinking glasses, crystal, oven-proof dishes, porcelain, ceramics</li> <li>Mirrors</li> <li>Bricks, concrete, stones (large amounts are delivered at Heggvin)</li> <li>Glass wool, mineral wool, insulation</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>

<p><b>Clothing, footwear and textiles</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clothes</li> <li>Shoes</li> <li>Towels</li> <li>Curtains, tablecloths</li> <li>Bed linen</li> </ul> <p>↓</p> <p>To be delivered to clothes recycling bins (also available at recycling stations), thrift stores, flea markets, or it can be given away, etc.</p>

<p><b>Plastic</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastic furniture</li> <li>Plastic buckets and tubs</li> <li>Plastic flower boxes, larger plastic items</li> <li>Polystyrene balls, coloured Polystyrene, plastic felts</li> </ul> <p>↓</p> <p><b>White Polystyrene</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clean and white Polystyrene packaging</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>

<p><b>Garden waste</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grass, leaves, plants</li> <li>Twigs, branches</li> <li>Christmas trees</li> </ul> <p>↓</p> <p><b>Lumber</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wooden planks/boards, wooden furniture</li> </ul> <p>↓</p> <p><b>Metal</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Scrap iron</li> </ul> <p>↓</p>

<p><b>Electrical items &amp; electronics</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Electric toys</li> <li>Mobile phones, telephones</li> <li>Cables</li> <li>Flashing shoes</li> <li>Hair dryers, irons, shavers</li> <li>Electric toothbrushes</li> <li>Computer equipment, TV's, radios</li> <li>Watches</li> <li>Kitchen appliances</li> </ul>

<p><b>Hazardous waste</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pressure treated lumber</li> <li>Paint, stain, varnish, white spirit</li> <li>Chemicals, cleaning products</li> <li>Spackle, adhesives</li> <li>Batteries</li> <li>Light bulbs, fluorescent lamps</li> <li>Spray and aerosol cans</li> <li>Pesticides</li> <li>Fryer oil, oil</li> <li>Flooring</li> </ul>

<p><b>Residual waste</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Soiled clothes, shoes, textiles</li> <li>Worn-out furniture</li> <li>Hard-cover books</li> <li>Foam rubber, mattresses</li> <li>Garden hoses, tarpaulins, firewood sacks</li> <li>Laminated flooring, bathroom wall panels</li> </ul> <p>↓</p> <p>Payment upon delivery, cheaper when residual waste is visible (loose/transparent bags) than delivery in opaque bags</p>
